

## Consent form and health declaration for vaccination against COVID-19

The Public Health Agency of Sweden recommends vaccination against COVID-19 for children aged 12 and over.

Vaccination against COVID-19 protects against serious cases of the disease, and is voluntary and free of charge.

### About the consent

On this form, you can indicate whether or not you consent to your child being vaccinated. If consent is not provided, your child cannot be vaccinated at school. Vaccination of a minor without the consent of a legal guardian can only be carried out following the conducting of an assessment of maturity by healthcare professionals. In such cases, the assessment of maturity is performed at a health center, at the request of the child.

To achieve the best effect, the vaccine is given twice, with a few weeks between each dose. More information is provided with the first vaccination. The consent applies to both doses.
